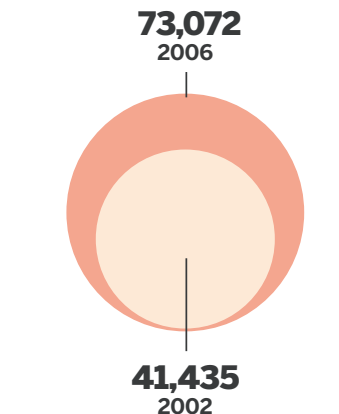
Television audience 2006
