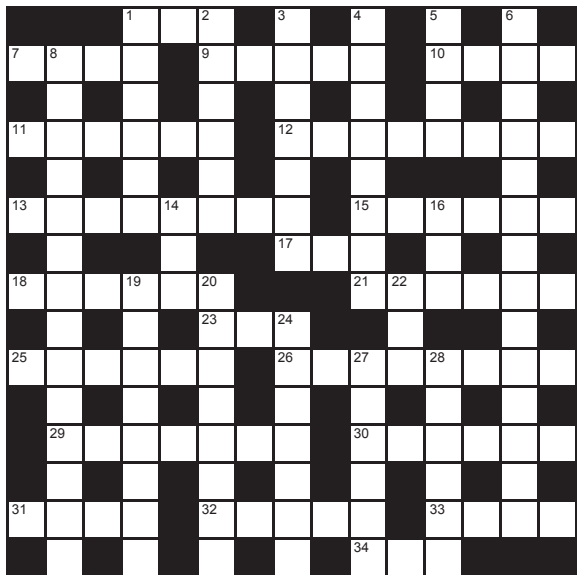


CROSSWORD
